

Frequently Asked Questions

Does the Library accept donations?

The Library accepts donations of clean, new or used books. Due to space limitations the Library does not accept:

- Reader's Digest condensed books
- Magazines
- Encyclopedia sets
- Textbooks older than 3 years

The Library also accepts donations by cash or check.

What are the requirements to obtain a library card?

Library cards will be issued to individuals over the age of 18:

- With a valid Michigan driver's license or State ID
- Current address in Wayne or Oakland counties (excluding the cities of Dearborn, Detroit, Troy, or Harper Woods).

Individuals under 18 must have parent or legal guardian sign the application; parent or legal guardian must present a valid Michigan driver's license or State ID.

Is there a fee for library cards?

There is no charge for the initial library card. Replacement cards cost \$3.00. Temporary Internet-Use only cards cost \$2.00. A library card is required for all transactions.

What services does the Library offer?

The Library offers programs for adults and children, 24 hour access to the online catalog iBistro, Internet access, color copier and faxing.

Does the Library provide access to the Internet?

The Library provides patrons with access to the Internet according to the terms of the Internet Use Policy.

- All patrons who wish to use the internet must register at the desk.
- 30 minute time limit if necessary.
- Limit 2 computer sign-ups per day.
- Black and white printing available for \$0.15 a page.
- Color printing available for \$0.75 a page.
- Additional limits may apply.
